## TASTING NOTES

This wine displays great depth and complexity in aromatics and flavor concentration. Raspberry, dark chocolate and coffee beans are balanced with spice rub, vanilla and cigar box notes. On the palate this wine showcases the great 2012 vintage in Napa while maintaining elegance and balance as well as allowing the fruit intensity to shine through.
